Love your baby. Bond with your baby.

But don't sleep with your baby.

In Louisiana, about 100 infants die of SIDS or suffocation every year. Keep your baby safe from sleep-related causes of infant death. For information on the steps to safe sleep for your baby, visit: **GiveYourBabySpace.org**

Follow the Steps to Safe Sleep!



- ☐ Baby is safest when you don't share a bed with him/her
- □ Baby should sleep alone in a crib or pack 'n play near you. Not in an adult bed, sofa or chair
- ☐ Baby sleeps on his/her back
- ☐ No pillows, no blankets, no bumper pads in the crib or pack 'n play
- □ No stuffed animals, no toys, no loose bedding in baby's sleep area
- ☐ Baby is dressed in lightweight clothing
- ☐ Keep crib or pack 'n play away from windows with curtains, blinds or cords
- ☐ No smoking around your baby

Try to check off as many items as possible.
